Topic: Computational Modeling and Digital Dysmorphology for Diverse Populations with Genetic Syndromes

Speaker details: **Dr.Marius George Linguraru**, Principal Investigator, Children's National Medical Center, Washington DC, USA

The speech elaborated about a genetic condition. The children experience a high incidence of serious medical complications and intellectual disability that require immediate treatment. Genetic conditions often present clinically with universally recognizable signs and symptoms, including recurring patterns of malformations on the face and body that are path genetically related. These patterns can be obvious or very subtle and manifest differently with age and ethnical background. However, quantitative facial measurements are not available to primary care physicians, pediatricians and neonatologist, nor are they performed in a standardized and reproducible fashion by geneticists. The mGene is a non-invasive, smart phone application that identifies a wide array of genetic syndromes. The technology detects specific, clinically-proven markers of these disorders using objective and quantitative facial analysis enhanced by machine learning.
